PITLOCHRY LASSIES

32 Bar Strathspey for a 4 couple set.

3rd and 4th couples begin on opposite sides.

BARS

- 1-8 1st and 2nd couples and at the same time 4th and 3rd couples dance the Bourell (or Birl).
- 9-16 2nd and 3rd couples (end couples) giving right hands, cross over and set, and repeat.

 Meanwhile: 1st and 4th couples (middle couples) dance rights and lefts, but on bars 15 and 16, 1st woman and 4th man and 1st man and 4th woman turn with left hands to put the women in the middle ready for the Targe.
- 17-24 1st and 4th couples dance the Targe to finish with the 1st couple in 3rd place on opposite sides and the 4th couple in 2nd place on own sides.
- 25-32 All 4 couples turn partners with right hands and then with left hands.

The dance was devised by Ruth Taylor to accompany the tune Ruth Frae Pitlochry written for her by Muriel Johnstone. The dance is dedicated to all the Scottish Country Dancing Lassies of Pitlochry past, present and future - especially my mother, Lillie Donald, and my dear friend, Ruth Cunnison, the other Ruth frae Pitlochry.
