The Registrar

32-bar strathspey for 3 couples in a 4-couple set

Bars

- 1-4 1st couple set and turn partner with both hands halfway round and finish in top place in the middle facing down, nearer hands joined.
- 5-8 1st couple dance down for 2 steps, then turn with both hands once round (no extra turn) to face 1st corners. 2nd couple step up on bars 5-6.
- 9-16 1st couple set to and turn 1st corners, then repeat with 2nd corners, finishing with 1st woman between 3rd couple and 1st man between 2nd couple, all facing down.
- Joining hands in lines of three, all dance down for 4 steps, pull back right shoulders and dance back up. On bar 24, 1st man pulls back right shoulder to face down.
- Reels of three across the dance, 1st couple giving right shoulder to the person on the right to begin [1st man gives right shoulder to 2nd man and 1st woman gives right shoulder to 3rd woman].
- 31-32 1st couple dance a petronella turn to 2nd place on own sides.

Repeat having passed a couple.

Note: At the end of bar 16, 1st man, pulling back his right shoulder, turns quickly and strongly to end facing down.

Recommended tune: *Mr. Fred Eustis of Windsor Mill* or other strong, traditional strathspey
