# Join us for the 22<sup>nd</sup> Scottish Weekend

**Scottish Weekend, Inc.** emphasizes the best in live music, fine teaching, and "controlled abandon." We begin Friday night with supper and a welcome dance. Two morning classes and one in the afternoon are offered on Saturday, followed by time to relax, swim in the pool, shop for Scottish goods, have a massage, and socialize. That evening, our piper leads us in a grand march to start an elegant full-dress ball. After another class on Sunday morning, all participants gather for the popular combined class, then lunch and farewells until next year. There will be a ceilidh after the Ball on Saturday.

**Scottish Country Dance** focused on Basic and Social dancing and Technique will be led by each of the three guest dance teachers. On Saturday afternoon, dancers may select one of the specialty classes offered by the teachers. Classes will be accompanied by our staff musicians.

**Children's Program:** If there is enough interest, we will offer an expanded program for children age 5 and up. A variety of activities will be offered Saturday morning. An afternoon children's dance class for children 7 years and older will be held at the same time as the ball review if interest merits. Details are on the web site.

**Four Music Classes**, this year taught by our staff musicians, are offered for all interested in making music for Scottish Country dancing. Key elements of playing for dances and classes will be taught: Scottish styling, tempo, backup, creating medleys and teacher-musician tips.

**Take the Music Home:** Our CDs "Memories of Scottish Weekend" ('98) and/or "More Memories of Scottish Weekend" ('02) purchased with your registration (\$13@ or 2 for \$25) will be available for pickup at camp. **Timber Ridge** is a beautiful property nestled in the heart of the Shenandoah Mountains of West Virginia. The camp is reasonably close to many major cities: Washington DC is 90 miles away, Philadelphia is 230 miles, Pittsburgh is 185 miles and New York is 300 miles. The closest airport is Dulles International Airport (IAD) in Dulles, VA.

The camp offers a variety of cabin styles with sinks, showers, toilets, and single beds, but neither pillows nor linens. There are wood floors in the main hall and fine arts building. The swimming pool, athletic facilities, and grounds provide settings for our special events and for visiting with friends throughout the weekend.

- The fee covers housing, tuition, and food from Friday supper through Sunday lunch. Beverages and souvenirs may be purchased at camp.
- All who participate in the dance classes and/or evening dances are expected to have a minimum of six months of Scottish Country Dance instruction (except children's classes).
- Spectators may participate in all activities except classes and evening dances.
- Children under 18 may attend if accompanied by a parent or by another adult when the registrar receives written parental permission at least three weeks in advance of the weekend. (The complete attendance policy is on our Web site.)

## Scholarships:

- Thanks to the generosity of other campers, scholarships for half the registration fee are available. Scholars will be asked to do some work at camp.
- We may also have limited full scholarships for participants who cannot otherwise attend the camp. See Registration form.
